

Parts of a Story

Every story has a beginning, a middle, and an end. It is written in paragraphs so that it is more organized. A good story has at least three paragraphs.

Beginning

The beginning tells when and where the story takes place. It is the first paragraph of the story.

Middle

The middle introduces a problem. It is usually made up of one or more paragraphs that tell the events of the story. It is the longest part of the story.

End

The end usually tells how the problem is solved. It is the last paragraph of the story.
